# THOUSANDS TO MARCH 4 DEMOCRACY IN WASHINGTON, D.C., FEB. 27-28

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5, 2026 – The [March 4 Democracy \(M4D\) coalition](#), a united, people-powered movement demanding a government that serves all Americans, will mobilize thousands of Americans in the nation's capital on Feb. 27-28 to defend democracy and confront the wealthy and political enablers behind the rampant corruption in the Trump administration.

"I'm a combat veteran, and my oath was to the Constitution—not to any individual or party," said Tom Sidle, the leader of March 4 Democracy. "'We The People' means all of us, and when our democracy is being tested, showing up matters. The Constitution isn't optional, and it's not negotiable."

On Friday, February 27th, attendees will join partner organizations and the congressional lobbying team from [FLARE](#), with support from the [Removal Coalition](#), to meet directly with elected officials and their staff at congressional offices to demand Donald Trump's impeachment, conviction, and removal from office. On Saturday, February 28th, tens of thousands will gather in the Capitol area for a mass rally and march to show the country—and those in power—that we are done waiting.

"We want our streets safe from harm and our neighbors free to exist without fear." Jasmine Johnson, executive director of the [Fight Against Fascism Organization](#), one of the M4D coalition partners, said. "Until our government fully represents each and every one of us, we will not be silent. This moment demands accountability, action, and a real commitment to defending democracy."

[Dozens of organizations](#) nationwide have signed on with the March 4 Democracy coalition. This unique and energized coalition brings together workers, families, immigrants, veterans, organizers, and community advocates from across the nation to confront corruption, denounce

"The Trump administration is disappearing people, killing our neighbors, and warehousing human beings in concentration camps while billionaires make record profits. This is not the America the majority of us want to live in," said Dave Mytych, FLARE's congressional outreach coordinator. "Democracy only survives when the people fight for it together. It starts with the demand to impeach, convict and remove Donald Trump."

M4D's partners are unions, advocacy groups, veterans' networks, civil rights organizations, immigrant-justice coalitions, LGBTQIA+ advocates, community organizers, and grassroots powerhouses. "Congress is complicit in every drop of blood shed due to this murderous regime, and We the People are no longer giving our lawmakers cover for their inaction," said Jessica Denson, founder of the Removal Coalition. "We are demanding that they honor their oath to impeach and remove Trump from office, and we are demanding it now."

# ABOUT MARCH 4 DEMOCRACY

## WHO WE ARE

March 4 Democracy (M4D) is a united, people-powered national movement demanding a government that serves the people, not billionaires, corporate interests, or authoritarian power.

We are veterans and military families. Workers and union members. Educators, students, faith leaders, organizers, and small business owners. We are immigrants, tribal communities, parents, and neighbors.

We represent communities that are tired of corruption being normalized, extremism being excused, and constitutional violations being treated as politics as usual.

We believe democracy belongs to the people, and when it is threatened, the people have a responsibility to show up and defend it.

On February 27th and 28th, 2026, thousands will gather in Washington, D.C. for a two-day national mobilization demanding accountability at the highest levels of government.

This is not a symbolic protest. This is organized civic pressure.

## WHAT MAKES M4D DIFFERENT

M4D is not a campaign. It is not affiliated with any political party. It is not funded by corporate donors or billionaires. It is a coalition of more than 40 partner organizations across the country, working across issue areas including:

- Veterans' issues and military accountability
- Affordable housing and living wages
- Voting rights and democratic representation
- Campaign finance and anti-corruption
- Racial justice and civil rights

- Healthcare and bodily autonomy

Unlike single-issue demonstrations, March 4 Democracy presents a unified accountability platform grounded in concrete policy demands. We are not asking for vague change. We are demanding specific action.

## WHY THIS MOMENT

The United States is not experiencing routine political disagreement. We are experiencing sustained democratic destabilization, blatant abuses of power, and widespread corruption that cannot be ignored.

Over the past year, the Trump administration has pushed the boundaries of executive power beyond precedent, testing whether constitutional guardrails still function, and whether Congress will enforce them. **We are witnessing:**

- Open defiance of constitutional norms and judicial authority
- Normalization of executive overreach and threats against political opponents
- Renewed efforts to undermine federal law enforcement independence
- Escalating attacks on voting access and election legitimacy
- State-sanctioned violence through aggressive and destabilizing immigration enforcement tactics
- Families separated and communities terrorized under expanded ICE operations
- Attempts to shield allies from scrutiny while weaponizing the justice system against critics and political opponents
- Continued public obfuscation around elite misconduct, including unresolved questions surrounding Jeffrey Epstein and powerful individuals connected to him
- The concentration of wealth and political influence among billionaires and mega-corporations with direct access to executive power
- The erosion of trust in institutions that are meant to serve the public, not protect the powerful

This is not about partisanship. It is about whether accountability applies equally.

When executive authority is abused, when ethical violations go uninvestigated, when federal power is used to intimidate communities, and when Congress fails to act decisively, civic engagement becomes an *obligation*, not an option.

Democracy does not collapse in a single moment. It erodes through normalization. March 4 Democracy exists because silence enables erosion. We reject silence.

## OUR STANCE

M4D demands full constitutional accountability for any elected official or cabinet member who violates the public trust. That includes the pursuit of impeachment proceedings where evidence supports removal from office.

We believe no president, no cabinet official, and no political figure is above the law.

Accountability is not partisan. It is foundational to democracy.

## TWO-DAY NATIONAL ACTION



### DAY 1: February 27, 2026

Advocacy and direct engagement on Capitol Hill, focused on impeachment advocacy, legislative accountability, and policy demands.



### DAY 2: February 28, 2026

Mass rally and march in Washington, D.C., uniting coalition partners, veterans, workers, and community leaders in a national demonstration of democratic power.

This is designed to convert presence into pressure—and pressure into action.

# LEGITIMACY & PRINCIPLES

March 4 Democracy is:

- Peaceful
- Community-funded
- Coalition-led
- Accountability-driven

We reject political violence. We reject authoritarianism. We reject corporate capture of democratic institutions. We stand for constitutional order, equal representation, and the principle that none of us are free until all of us are free.

# CORE DEMANDS

## ACCOUNTABILITY. DIGNITY. DEMOCRACY THAT WORKS FOR THE PEOPLE.

March 4 Democracy is not built on slogans. It is built on enforceable demands rooted in constitutional accountability and human dignity.

We are calling for immediate action across the following pillars:

### I. FULL CONSTITUTIONAL ACCOUNTABILITY

No president. No cabinet official. No billionaire ally is above the law. We demand:

- Immediate impeachment and removal proceedings for Donald Trump and any cabinet official found to have violated constitutional oath, obstructed justice, abused executive authority, or weaponized federal power for political retaliation.
- Independent investigations into executive interference with federal law enforcement, judicial defiance, freedom of the press, and politicized prosecutions.
- Full transparency regarding elite misconduct, including unresolved questions surrounding Jeffrey Epstein, his network, and any public officials shielded from scrutiny.
- Restoration of Department of Justice independence and strict enforcement of conflict-of-interest laws.
- Reestablishment of federal civil rights enforcement authority under Title VI and disparate impact protections.

Accountability is not revenge. It is the foundation of a functioning republic.

## II. END STATE-SANCTIONED CRUELTY

Federal power must never be used to terrorize communities. **We demand:**

- The abolition of ICE and immediate oversight into abusive raids, family separations, and tactics that destabilize communities.
- Guaranteed due process rights for all individuals within U.S. jurisdiction.
- Humane, rights-based immigration policy grounded in constitutional protections and international human rights standards.
- Independent investigation into crimes committed under federal authority, including the executions of Ruben Martinez, Alex Pretti, Renee Good, Keith Porter, and the 30+ other lives lost at the hands of DHS since the start of Donald Trump's second term.

Security does not require cruelty. Law enforcement does not require dehumanization.

## III. PROTECT AND EXPAND DEMOCRATIC RIGHTS

The right to vote and be represented is non-negotiable. **We demand:**

- Federal protections for voting rights nationwide and bolstered safeguards against executive interference in elections.
- Implementation of ranked-choice voting to ensure fairer representation.
- D.C. statehood and voting representation in Congress for U.S. territories.
- The overturning of *Citizens United v. FEC*, elimination of unlimited corporate and billionaire political spending, stronger transparency for political donations, and the abolition of Super PACs.

Democracy does not function when voting rights are weakened, representation is denied, elections are manipulated, and a single billionaire or corporation can outspend entire communities. Political power must flow from voters.

## IV. ECONOMIC JUSTICE & ANTI-CORRUPTION

Government must serve people, not oligarchs. **We demand:**

- Equitable taxation of the wealthy and elimination of tax loopholes that allow extreme wealth concentration.
- Strict prohibitions on financial conflicts of interest between elected officials and corporate entities.
- Regulation of corporate housing ownership to protect community affordability.
- Federal minimum wage of \$28/hour tied to regional cost-of-living benchmarks.
- Public accountability for utilities and corporate rate structures that shift costs onto working families.

A democracy captured by wealth and privilege is not a real democracy.

## V. VETERANS & MILITARY FAMILIES FIRST

Those who served must never be used as political shields while being denied care.

**We demand:**

- Immediate access to comprehensive physical and mental healthcare for all service members and veterans.
- Survivor-centered accountability and reporting reform for Military Sexual Trauma.
- Restoration of benefits and gender-affirming care for all Trans service members and veterans.
- Modernization of Veterans Readiness and Employment (VRE) programs aligned with local labor markets.
- Reallocation of Department of Defense spending toward veterans, the unhoused, and vulnerable communities.

Patriotism is measured by how we *treat* those who served, not by rhetoric.

## VI. HEALTHCARE AS A HUMAN RIGHT

Healthcare is not a privilege for the insured and wealthy. **We demand:**

- A universal healthcare system built on a public option infrastructure.
- National protection of reproductive healthcare and bodily autonomy.
- Restoration of federal funding for Planned Parenthood within Hyde Amendment parameters.
- Universal dental, vision, and hearing coverage.
- Federal regulation of prescription drug pricing to prevent profit-driven exploitation.
- National protection of gender-affirming care access.

Medical care must never be a political weapon.

## VII. JUSTICE & REFORM

Justice must repair, not perpetuate harm. **We demand:**

- Transition from punitive incarceration models to restorative justice systems.
- End to prison privatization and prohibition of prison labor exploitation.
- Federal civil rights enforcement protections across housing, employment, and education.
- Protection of marriage equality and equal protection under the law.

Justice must serve communities, not profit structures.

# THIS IS NOT A ONE-DAY DEMAND

February 27–28, 2026 is a mobilization point, not an endpoint. March 4 Democracy exists

to convert public presence into sustained civic pressure until accountability is restored and structural reform begins.

We march because the Constitution demands enforcement. We march because communities deserve protection. We march because democracy cannot defend itself.

# COALITION & SOLIDARITY ACTIONS

## A NATIONAL ALIGNMENT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY

March 4 Democracy is not organized by a single individual, political campaign, or centralized authority. It is a coordinated coalition of more than 40 partner organizations representing veterans, workers, educators, civil rights advocates, faith leaders, organizers, advocates, and community networks across the country.

This coalition reflects the breadth of communities directly impacted by executive overreach, democratic erosion, economic inequality, and state-sanctioned harm. **Our partners span a wide range of pro-democracy and accountability-focused work, including:**

- Constitutional accountability and impeachment advocacy
- Defense of democratic institutions and opposition to authoritarian governance
- Voting rights and election protection
- Anti-corruption and campaign finance reform
- Veterans and constitutional oath-based organizing
- Immigration justice and opposition to abusive federal enforcement practices
- Civil rights and equal protection advocacy
- Economic justice and opposition to corporate capture of government
- Media accountability and resistance to disinformation
- Nonviolent direct action, protest safety, and disciplined civic mobilization

Together, these organizations represent a broad alignment of communities committed to protecting constitutional governance, civil liberties, and equal representation under the law.

We reject political violence. We reject extremist ideology. We reject corporate capture of public institutions. We stand unified in the belief that democracy must serve the people, not protect the wealthy and powerful.

# MOMENTUM & SUPPORT

## GROWING NATIONAL ALIGNMENT

March 4 Democracy is not an isolated call to action. It is the convergence of organizing already underway across the country. **Since its launch, the movement has:**

- Built a coalition of more than 40 partner organizations spanning multiple states and regions.
- Activated organizers across local communities preparing travel, outreach, and coordinated programming for February 27 – 28.
- Generated national digital engagement through livestreams, independent media coverage, and creator amplification.
- Launched solidarity actions beyond Washington, D.C., demonstrating geographic breadth.

M4D's coalition partners bring established organizing networks, trained marshals, communications teams, veteran leaders, and policy advocates prepared to sustain pressure beyond a single weekend. Momentum is not measured only by attendance. It is measured by infrastructure.

## VETERANS & CROSS-MOVEMENT SUPPORT

Veterans and constitutional oath-based organizers play a visible role within the coalition, reinforcing the movement's commitment to lawful accountability and defense of democratic institutions.

The coalition also includes long-standing pro-democracy networks, impeachment advocacy groups, media accountability organizers, and nonviolent direct action leaders.

## INDEPENDENT MEDIA & CREATOR ENGAGEMENT

Independent national media voices and digital creators have engaged with the movement,

helping expand reach beyond traditional outlets and bringing accountability conversations to millions of viewers online.

Creators, livestream teams, and community journalists are invited to document, question, and amplify the mobilization in real time.

## **SUSTAINED CIVIC PRESSURE**

March 4 Democracy is built for continuation beyond February 27 – 28. Coalition partners are coordinating:

- Legislative advocacy following the march
- Ongoing impeachment pressure campaigns
- Community forums and public education initiatives
- Continued collaborative organizing and accountability tracking

The mobilization in Washington is a convergence point, not a conclusion.

# MEDIA FAQs

## IS MARCH 4 DEMOCRACY AFFILIATED WITH A POLITICAL PARTY OR CAMPAIGN?

No. March 4 Democracy is not affiliated with any political party or electoral campaign. It is a coalition-based civic mobilization focused on constitutional accountability, democratic reform, and protection of civil rights.

Participants may hold a range of political identities. The unifying principle is accountability under the Constitution.

## IS THIS EVENT PEACEFUL?

Yes. March 4 Democracy is committed to nonviolent civic engagement. Coalition partners adhere to principles of disciplined, peaceful protest and constitutional advocacy.

The movement rejects political violence, property destruction, and intimidation tactics. Read our full [Non-Violence Statement](#).

## WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE MOBILIZATION?

The two-day mobilization in Washington, D.C. is structured as:

- **February 27:** Advocacy and direct engagement with lawmakers focused on impeachment, oversight, and legislative accountability.
- **February 28:** A mass rally and march demonstrating national demand for constitutional enforcement and democratic reform.

The goal is to convert public presence into sustained civic pressure.

## ARE YOU EXPLICITLY CALLING FOR IMPEACHMENT OF DONALD TRUMP?

Yes. March 4 Democracy demands the impeachment, conviction, and removal of Donald Trump and any cabinet official found to have violated constitutional oath, obstructed justice, abused executive authority, or engaged in corruption.

Accountability is not partisan. It is constitutional. No elected official is above the law.

## WHY INCLUDE REFERENCES TO JEFFREY EPSTEIN OR ELITE MISCONDUCT?

Transparency and accountability must apply equally, including to powerful individuals and political elites.

The public has legitimate, unresolved questions regarding networks of influence and misconduct involving Jeffrey Epstein, Ghislaine Maxwell, Donald Trump, Bill Clinton, Howard Lutnick, and many other powerful figures.

March 4 Democracy supports full, independent investigation wherever credible evidence warrants scrutiny, regardless of party, occupation, or wealth. Shielding powerful actors from accountability erodes public trust.

## WHAT IS YOUR POSITION ON IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT AND ICE?

March 4 Democracy opposes abusive and destabilizing federal immigration enforcement practices that separate families, terrorize communities, or violate due process.

We demand the abolition of ICE and support humane, rights-based immigration reform grounded in constitutional protections. Immigration policy must not come at the expense of civil liberties.

## WHO FUNDS MARCH 4 DEMOCRACY?

**Short answer:** not George Soros. March 4 Democracy is a coalition-driven mobilization supported by participating organizations and grassroots contributors. The movement does not receive funding from corporate PACs, billionaire patrons, or major institutional donors. **Funding is generated through:**

- Small-dollar individual donations
- Coalition partner contributions
- Merchandise sales
- Community-based fundraising efforts

M4D is powered by everyday people who believe in constitutional accountability and democratic reform. Financial transparency and independence are core to the movement's credibility.

## WHO IS ORGANIZING THE EVENT?

The mobilization is coordinated by a coalition of more than 40 partner organizations across the country. The coalition structure is decentralized but strategically aligned, with designated media contacts and trained organizers supporting the event.

## ARE PERMITS SECURED?

The coalition is coordinating all required permits and compliance measures in accordance with local and federal regulations. March 4 Democracy is committed to lawful assembly and civic engagement.

## HOW LARGE DO YOU EXPECT TURNOUT TO BE?

We currently have thousands of confirmed registrations for the Washington, D.C., mobilization. However, registration numbers have proven to be an unreliable measure of turnout under the current political climate. Many people are understandably hesitant to publicly register for protests given documented retaliation, targeting of dissenters, and escalating rhetoric against political opposition.

Historically, turnout at coalition-led events has significantly exceeded formal registration numbers. With more than 40 partner organizations mobilizing nationwide, solidarity actions forming across multiple states, and transportation being coordinated regionally, we expect a strong and visible presence of thousands in D.C., and thousands more nationwide.

The demand for accountability is broader than what any online registration form can measure.

# CONCLUSION

## THIS IS A CONSTITUTIONAL MOMENT

March 4 Democracy is a response to a defining moment in American history. When executive power expands beyond its limits, when corruption is normalized, when billionaires exert disproportionate influence, and when federal authority is used to intimidate communities, civic engagement becomes a responsibility.

February 27–28, 2026 is not simply a protest. It is a coordinated national demand for constitutional accountability, democratic reform, and equal protection under the law.

The American system was built with mechanisms for correction. Those mechanisms clearly require public pressure to function. March 4 Democracy exists to apply that pressure—peacefully, lawfully, and visibly.

Democracy is not self-enforcing. It depends on participation.
